- The band was founded in 1973 as „UNIVERSUM“
- Walter Schubert and Eddi Förster as founder members still attend the band
- First recording in 1975
- Several prizes for the show concept and concerts
- Touring through entire Germany with a huge stage show
- In 1982 officially becoming a professional band; first album at AMIGA (big East German record label in Berlin)
- Touring through Bulgaria, Hungary, Czech Republic as well as the Soviet Union
- In 1990 renaming in „THE GOLDEN SIXTIES BAND“
- Since 1992 guest performances in Germany, Austria, Belgium and the Netherlands
- Touring with many original bands and artists from the sixties and seventies
- Gigs for the German TV channels ARD, ZDF, RTL and at other well-known TV and radio events
- Since 1998 constant member constellation
- Since 2001 regular band of CHRIS ANDREWS und GRAHAM BONNEY
- Gigs in the entire European Union
